



APPROVAL TO CONDUCT RETURN TO TRAIN/ PLAY CRICKET RELATED ACTIVITIES UNDER ALERT LEVEL 1 LOCKDOWN: CAPE TOWN CRICKET CLUB

Approval is hereby granted to the **CAPE TOWN CRICKET CLUB** by the Western Province Cricket Association in terms of the Government Gazette 43725 of 18 September 2020) as adapted by Gazette 43727 of 20 September 2020 under lockdown Alert Level 1 to **commence with cricket activities** in terms of the approved guidelines and strict medical protocols as stipulated in the *WPCA Policy Directive: Return To Train/ Play – Policy Guidelines For Amateur Cricket Under Level 1 Lockdown* and *CSA Guidelines For Return To Train/ Play Amateur Cricket Under Level 1 Lockdown*.

These measures will remain in place until declared otherwise by the Minister of Sport & Culture and Regulations and Directions as amended issued under the Disaster Management Act 57 of 2002 and as approved and guided by Cricket South Africa and Western Province Cricket Association.

The City of Cape Town, as the owner of the municipal sports facilities/ venues utilised by the **CAPE TOWN CRICKET CLUB**, has provided written permission to your club to utilise these sports facilities/ venue on condition that these facilities are available and booked following the Recreation & Parks booking process (*COCT: Access and Usage of Cricket Facilities Under Alert Level 1 dated 20 October 2020 and 15 October 2020*).

This **approval is granted subject to the exoneration and indemnification of Cricket South Africa, Western Province Cricket Association and The City of Cape Town** against all possible injury and COVID-19 related claims that may arise from **CAPE TOWN CRICKET CLUB** use of chosen sports venue (**24 Victoria Road, Plumstead, Cape Town**) whilst conducting/ performing cricket related activities.
